Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said to Abram: "Get out of your country, From your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you."

Romans 6:11 Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

po,rnoj pornos, immoral, not just sexually, but someone who engages in behind-the-scenes manipulation that is unethical and unprofessional.

pleone,kthj *pleonektes*; someone who is obviously operating on power lust and materialism lust.

a[rpax harpax; rapacious, ravenous, a swindler. Again someone who manifest criminality to achieve their aims. A thief.

2 Thessalonians 3:6 But we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you withdraw from every brother who walks disorderly and not according to the tradition which he received from us.

- 2 Thessalonians 3:14 And if anyone does not obey our word in this epistle, note that person and do not keep company with him, that he may be ashamed.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:15 Yet do not count him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.

Romans 16:17 Now I urge you, brethren, note those who cause divisions and offenses, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them.

Romans 16:18 For those who are such do not serve our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly, and by smooth words and flattering speech deceive the hearts of the simple.

1 Peter 4:4 In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with them in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of you.

Proverbs 1:10 My son, if sinners entice you, do not consent.

Proverbs 1:11 If they say, "Come with us, let us lie in wait to shed blood; Let us lurk secretly for the innocent without cause;"

Proverbs 1:12 "Let us swallow them alive like Sheol, and whole, like those who go down to the Pit;
Proverbs 1:13 We shall find all kinds of precious possessions, we shall fill our houses with spoil;"

Proverbs 1:14 "Cast in your lot among us, let us all have one purse—"
Proverbs 1:15 My son, do not walk in the way with them, keep your foot from their path;

Proverbs 1:16 For their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed blood.

Proverbs 1:17 Surely, in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird;

Proverbs 1:18 But they lie in wait for their own blood, they lurk secretly for their own lives.

Proverbs 1:19 So are the ways of everyone who is greedy for gain; it takes away the life of its owners.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: "Evil company corrupts good habits."

Separation from unbelievers when doctrine is compromised — 2 Corinthians 6:14; Hebrews 13:13.

2 Corinthians 6:14 Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness?

 Separation from believers enmeshed in religious modes of operation and apostasy. 2 Corinthians 6:17 Therefore "Come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you."

2 Timothy 3:5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

Jeremiah 2:24 A wild donkey accustomed to the wilderness, that sniffs the wind in her passion. In the time of her heat who can turn her away? All who seek her will not become weary; in her month they will find her. Jeremiah 2:25 Withhold your foot from being unshod, and your throat from thirst. But you said, "There is no hope. No! For I have loved aliens, and after them I will go."
