IMITATORS OF CHRIST Are We Willing to Love as Christ Loved Us? John 13:34–35 John 20:31, "but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name."

John 13:34, "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

John 13:35, "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

1 Cor. 13:4, "Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant" [NASB],

φυσιόω *phusioō* pres mid indic 3 sing "to be puffed up, conceited, think more of yourself than you ought, to be arrogant and self-absorbed."

Phil. 2:3, "Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself."

Col. 3:12, "Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, <u>humility, meekness</u>, longsuffering;"

ταπεινοφροσύνη tapeinophrosune humility, unassuming, often negative, powerless, unimportant, irrelevant, not seeking or asserting one's own rights.

πραΰτης *prautēs* gen fem sing humility, trans frequently as meekness, considerate, gentle, Gal. 5:23; Col. 3:12.

Num. 12:3, "(Now the man Moses was very humble [LXX π ραΰς $pra\ddot{u}s$], more than all men who were on the face of the earth.)"

Col. 3:13, "bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.

Col. 3:14, "But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection."

1 Pet. 5:5, "Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for 'God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.'" [Prov. 3:4]

Eph. 4:30, "And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

χαρίζομαι *charizomai* pres mid part masc plur nom to give, favor, forgive participle of means, "by forgiving"

Eph. 3:17, "that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being <u>rooted</u> and grounded in love,

Eph. 3:18, "may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—

Eph. 3:19, "to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."

John 15:10, "If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love."

John 15:12, "This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.

John 15:13, "Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends."

John 15:17, "These things I command you, that you love one another."
