## **Guard Against False Teachers**

Ezek. 16:49, "Look, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom: She and her daughter <u>had pride</u>, fullness of food, and abundance of idleness; neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy." <u>2 Peter 2:4</u>, "For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell [*tartarus*] and delivered them to chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment;" <u>2 Peter 2:5, "and did not spare</u> the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly;"

φείδομαι pheidomai 3 sing aor mid indic to spare, to refrain from something, in other words, to deal with someone leniently (same as in 2 Peter 2:4)

<u>2 Pet. 2:6</u>, "and turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes, condemned them to destruction, making them an example to those who afterward would live ungodly;

<u>2 Pet. 2:7</u>, "and delivered righteous Lot, who was oppressed by the filthy conduct of the wicked

<u>2 Pet. 2:8</u>, "(for that righteous man, dwelling among them, tormented his righteous soul from day to day by seeing and hearing their lawless deeds)—" Jude 6, "And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day,"

> oἰκητήριον oikētěrion "habitation or dwelling place"

Jude 7, "just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities (fem. pl. noun) around them [fem. pl.], since they [fem. pl.: the cities] in the same way as these [masc. pl. angels, vs. 6] indulged in gross immorality and went after strange flesh, are exhibited as an example in undergoing the punishment of eternal fire."

Jude 7, "as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities around them in a similar manner to these, having given themselves over to sexual immorality and gone after strange flesh, are set forth as an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire."

Rom. 1:22, "Professing to be wise, they became fools,

Rom. 1:23, "and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things."
